



Hempnall Parish Council wishes to recommend approval of the above application with the following conditions:

1. Hempnall Parish Council has adopted Norfolk County Council's Environmental Lighting Zones' Policy, which classifies Hempnall as a Rural Dark Landscape. Furthermore the Parish Council conducts its business within the requirements of NPPF statement 125 (2012) and SNC policy IMP 25. NPPF Clause 125 states that: "planning policies and decisions should limit the impact of light pollution from artificial light on local amenity, intrinsically dark landscapes and nature conservation." Therefore Exterior lighting (associated with this development) is to be kept to a minimum. In order to limit light pollution, outdoor lights are to be full cut off flat glass and switched on only when needed (no dusk to dawn sodium lamps for example).
2. Hempnall Parish Council appreciates the efforts made by Hempnall School to limit the impact of its existing outdoor lighting on the rural setting in which the school is located. Lights are white and only switched on when required. The lighting brochure included with this planning application indicates that the new walkway lighting bollards will be Thorn LED fittings. We welcome the use of white LED lights - they are far less urbanising in their impact than either pink high pressure sodium lamps or orange low pressure sodium lamps. We ask that the new LED lights will be subject to the same timing restraints as currently apply to the existing exterior lights i.e. they will not be left on from dusk to dawn.
