Sorry for any confusion caused. We will also be sending this through to the Council.

This confirms the proposed hedgerow to the north of the solar array. Could you confirm in the meantime if this affects your comments in any way. In your view would the planting behind the panels reduce the risk of the panels breaking the skyline. We could possibly look at incorporating some trees in this planting if that would be more beneficial?
