Proposal:

Creation of a new recycling centre (RC) to deal with household waste and small amounts of trade waste. RC includes creation of a concrete pad and erection of new staff welfare office and reuse shop (with photovoltaic panels) for onsite sale of items suitable for reuse and ancillary small-scale sale of non-recycled items (Christmas trees, logs, compost bins and green waste sacks). Creation of a new access onto the A148 Holt Road with the closure of the eastern end of the existing Holt Road and reinstatement to highway verge.
