New comments have been received for application FUL/2023/0005 [REDACTED].

Comments:

It makes complete sense to re-site the recycling centre directly opposite the existing location in the field which will allow for further expansion if required. To expand in to the adjacent woodland as the original planning proposal would mean cutting down trees, loss of habitat and restrictions for further expansion. To move the recycling to another completely different location will raise objections from others as they won't want it near them either. This site is ideally located away from any residential areas and beside the A148 with good access, it is also central between Holt and Cromer. Businesses already operate in close proximity to this site i.e. two working quarries, Anglian Water together with several large local businesses. If it was re-sited to the industrial estate on the eastern side of Cromer as suggested this would increase traffic through Cromer town centre and add more carbon footprint to all people to the west of Cromer. The facility has to remain where it is.
