Comments:

Having viewed the amended plans and supporting information, I still fully support this application and applaud the council's proposed alterations to create an even more visually, environmentally and sustainably sympathetic recycling centre.

The addition of more living acoustic fencing to reduce the visual and aural impact on the area will no doubt be appealing to neighbours of the site, and will also provide a habitat for insects and other small animals.

I believe that the proposed location of the new centre is the only viable option, as expanding the existing site will only lead to trees being cut down and being so close to a main road could have safety and damage implications from passing traffic.

I also think that the AONB planning policy needs to be relaxed somewhat in this case. The policy allows development if there is a significant economic benefit, so the application must be passed to ensure economic and environmental growth, protection and longevity for North Norfolk.
