Comments:

The proposed new recycling centre is absolutely the right thing for the area. The acceptance of trade waste will be hugely beneficial to local builders and construction companies who will save a lot of time and money. Expanding the existing site will require the removal of mature trees which is detrimental to the natural habitat and screening of the site. The industrial site in Cromer is situated on a slope which has recorded landslides, and the added weight of the new apparatus will be detrimental to ground stability.
