## PROPOSED AGGREGATE AND SOIL RECOVERY FACILITY (PART RETROSPECTIVE).

Thank you for your consultation dated 23 June 2023, for the above application. We have reviewed the documents as submitted and are raising an objection on the proposed development, unless a Preliminary Risk Assessment is submitted for reviewed. We have provided further details below.

## **Preliminary Risk Assessment**

The PRA preliminary risk assessment will need to identify:

- all previous uses
- potential contaminants associated with those uses
- a conceptual model of the site indicating sources, pathways and receptors
- potentially unacceptable risks arising from contamination at the site.

Please note, that submission of a PRA will not guarantee removal of our objection, and this must first be reviewed before we determine our position.

## **Environmental Permit**

Newall Plant Limited currently have a standard rules Environmental Permit, SR2010 No.12, for the treatment of waste to produce soil, soil substitutes and aggregate. The current permit covers the waste activities proposed in the planning application (treatment of unprocessed materials using crushing and screening machinery). It is noted that the submitted planning application covers only the north/north eastern area of the current permit boundary.

Emissions from the waste activities, including noise, vibration and dust, will be regulated under the permit and must not exceed levels likely to cause a pollution outside of the site. Appropriate measures to minimise emissions must be implemented and followed by the operator.
