**Comments:**

I am writing to express my concerns about the lorries serving the Newall plant. What environmental impact and risk assessments have been made on the lorry route through Spooner Row which links the A11 to the plant site? As a resident of Spooner Row, I believe this is not a suitable route as it impacts on the users of the primary school, the village hall, the church, the pub, the level crossing, residents, pedestrians, and other vehicles using this route. There is a tight 5-way junction opposite the pub which can be quite hazardous. It is not unusual for lorries to mount the pavement on Station Rd as they pass each other due to the restrictive road width. There is the nuisance of dust from passing lorries, the noise, the lack of consideration for others, and feeling unsafe walking on the pavement. Spooner Row is a rural village and cannot provide a suitable route for more lorries. The Newall plant continues to expand. FUL/2023/0019 needs to be refused with the decision enforced.
