



## **Carbrooke: Request for EIA Scoping Opinion: Extension of quarry into MIN 200**

### **Carbrooke Quarry: MIN 200**

Thank you for consulting the highway authority.

In principle there are no fundamental highway concerns given that there is an established quarry working and adequate means of access to Summer Lane.

The full application should consider extant highway conditions associated with the current quarry workings.

The following will also need attention:

- i) Adequate visibility on Summer Lane to DMRB standards (may entail vegetation cutting periodically)
- ii) HGV route to primary road network
- iii) Provision of adequate carriageway width on Summer Lane (verge wearing observed near site that may require carriageway widening)
- iv) Wheel washing (to deal with dirt on the highway)
