Thanks for consulting us about the above EIA scoping opinion.

In line with Development Management Policy DM9, we would recommend that the Environmental Impact Assessment includes an archaeological desk-based assessment report approved by this office. We don't believe that any further archaeological surveys are necessary at this stage, but archaeological mitigation will be necessary and can be secured by planning condition if planning permission is granted. This is because there are no known heritage assets within the development area, but there is a possibility that unknown (at present) heritage assets will be present and will be adversely affected by the proposed quarrying.

A brief for the archaeological desk-based assessment is available from this office.
