## Site and Proposal

See the previous report held on application file FUL/2023/0033 for site and proposal details of the planning permission. The condition and details pursuant to this application are:

• Condition 3 (scheme for the management of surface water)
Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 3.3.5 of submitted document titled Environmental Statement; unreferenced; prepared by David L Walker Limited; dated August 2023, and the email reference B92/2 from David L Walker Limited to Norfolk County Council dated 08 January 2024 16:23 hours, within three months of the date of this permission details of a scheme for the management of surface water shall be submitted to the County Planning Authority for its approval in writing. The scheme shall also include details of the maintenance and management of all the surface water drainage features.

The scheme shall thereafter be implemented in accordance with the approved details and retained in perpetuity, and be managed and maintained in accordance with the approved details in perpetuity.

Reason: To ensure the effective management of surface water and to ensure clear arrangements are in place for ongoing operation and maintenance of the surface water drainage system, in accordance with Policy DM4 of the Norfolk Minerals and Waste Core Strategy 2010-2026, and paragraph 175 of the National Planning Policy Framework (2023)
