There is currently insufficient evidence for us to comment on. We have noted the proximity of residential dwellings near the proposed development. We would therefore like to see a report assessing the potential impacts of noise, dust/ air quality (both from transport and quarrying), lighting, safety measures/anti-social behaviour prevention, impacts on groundwater/ water resources. We would also recommend that the applicant refers to the 2016 IAQM Guidance on the Assessment of Mineral Dust Impacts for Planning.
