**Comments:**

The proposal does not take into consideration the effect on those living further south of the West Winch proposal who will still suffer from extreme congestion leading up to the relief road.

We have constant stagnant traffic movement outside our houses causing access issues onto the A10 in either direction and the pollution that it causes.

Due to the increase in traffic and the speed that they are doing we are unable to cross the road to access public transport.

From the Oakham roundabout to the post office at West Winch there is no safe crossing facility. The elderly, vulnerable and children have to run across the road to get to the other side at great physical risk.

It is disappointing that this stretch of road has not been considered; however with such a high figure of funding and investment being put into the new development, surely we should expect some assistance with traffic calming and crossings to allow residents outside of the development area with a decent standard of living
