Comments:

I am completely and utterly object to the ridiculous, ill-thought out proposed development and subsequent excuse for a new, alternative A10 road. An access road, with 5 roundabouts, to eventually carry the existing A10 traffic volumes, plus an additional circa, 5k+ cars, and HGVs, buses, etc. is frankly ludicrous. The Hardwick roundabout serves as an already dangerous bottleneck, why is it even a consideration to build near it? There are way more suitable sites, than the proposed parcel of land. Not least the hectares of land the other side of West Winch Common, with it's existing railway line, that runs directly into King's Lynn. Why not relocate the KL train station there, and have an express bus to connect to the in-town station, and a proper park and ride. Redevelop the under-utilised Saddlebow Industrial Estate, it's prime and would support a much bigger housing development, and is large enough to built a proper road that bypasses West Winch completely.
